

FSA Approval of L6 assessment equivalency

The following statement has been released from the FSA, outlining the assessment equivalency and requirements as part of the CSA L6 Trading standards practitioner apprenticeship, to transition into the CTSI Qualification Framework.

Assessment of equivalency

The following assessments of equivalency have been made and attain the equivalent level of knowledge and skills as the CTSI Trading Standards Practitioner Certificate with the Food Standards or Feed unit from the Trading Standards Practitioner Diploma

Food Standards

We have considered when students on the Level 6 Trading Standards Professional (L6 TSP) apprenticeship will have the knowledge and skills equivalent to the 'suitable qualification' requirements for food standards enforcement (Chapter 3.4.2 of the Food Law Code of Practice (England), June 2023).

Our assessment has determined that the following elements of the L6 TSP are equivalent to the CTSI Trading Standards Practitioner Certificate with the Food Standards unit from the Trading Standards Practitioner Diploma qualification:

- 1. Level 6 Trading Standards Professional apprenticeship 24-month course^[1] provided by Credit Services Association (CSA):
 - Completed the specialist Food module and have their course work audited and approved by CTSI.
 - Passed the CTSI Qualification Framework Food oral assessment.
